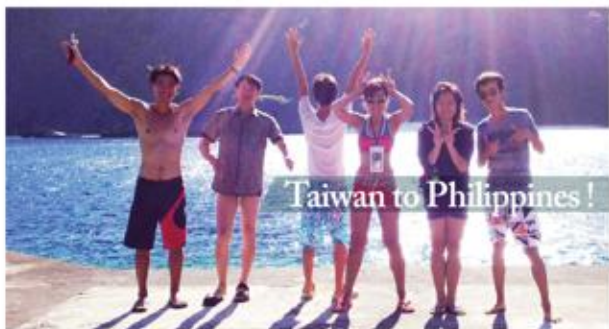

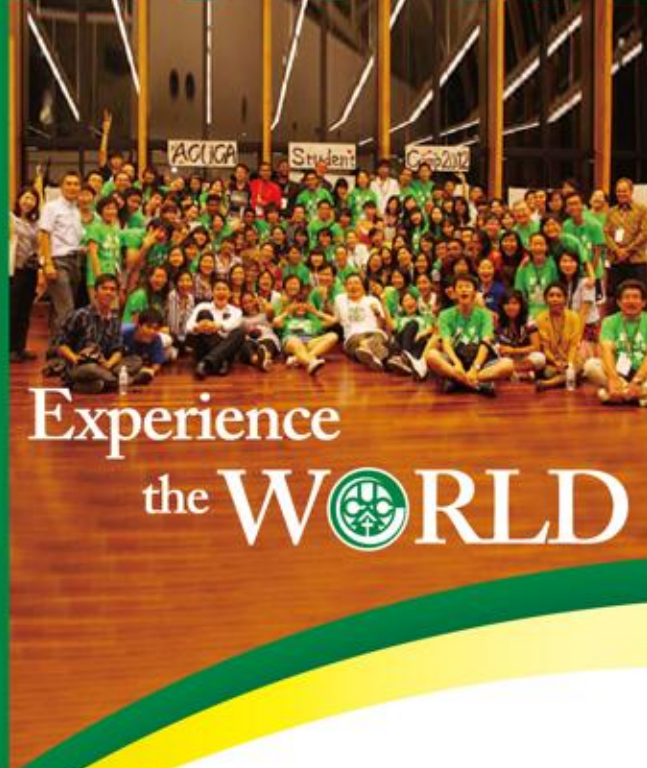

About ACUCA

The Association of Christian Universities and Colleges in Asia (ACUCA) was established in 1976, with the purpose of helping Christian institutions in the area.

ACUCA's mission is to help institutions to:

- Develop and maintain their Christian character.
- Enrich the quality of their educational programs and those of the other institutions of learning.
- Re-examine the relevance of their objectives and programs in relation to the needs of a changing society.

Currently, ACUCA has fifty-seven member institutions from eight Asian countries/regions: Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, the Philippines, Taiwan and Thailand.

Student Mobility Scheme

The ACUCA Student Mobility Scheme (SMS) was established in 2002 with the aim of fostering intercultural understanding among participating members. Under this scheme, member institutions that have classes taught in English in either regular semester or summer session are invited to waive tuition to enable their students to study at an institution outside of their country for a semester or during the summer. Since the Student Mobility Scheme was introduced in 2002, more than 50 students benefited from this program.

Subsidies are also available to students who participate in the scheme.

To nominate your students to the ACUCA SMS, please go through the following steps:

Step 1 Applicant Eligibility

- ◆ Please first ensure whether your students are eligible to apply for the SMS before your nomination on <http://www.acuca.net/application-process.html>
- ◆ If your institution is not a SMS participating institution, please contact the ACUCA Secretariat for further details.

THEN

Step 2 Nomination of your students to SMS participating institutions

- ◆ To nominate a student(s) to a SMS participating institution, please contact the host institution where the applicant(s) wish to enroll and prepare for the required application materials following their instructions.
- ◆ When you officially nominate your students to SMS institutions, please also submit a nomination form to the Secretariat to confirm the number of participants.

THEN

Step 3 Application for subsidies

- ◆ Those who are accepted by the host institution under ACUCA SMS are eligible to apply for subsidies. Their home institution should submit a form and required documents, including a copy of their acceptance letter and a copy of the receipt for the student's flight tickets, to the ACUCA Secretariat by designate dates.
- ◆ The Executive Committee will decide the amount of airfare and living expenses subsidies for the student(s) within the limits of the budget.
