Christian University of Thailand is located in Nakhon Pathom Province, 31 miles west of Bangkok, the capital of Thailand.

Nakhon Pathom is a lush agricultural and Buddhist heritage area, and is famous for a vast variety of fruits, "the Phra Pathom Chedi", the largest Buddhist stupa in the world, and for the Sanam Chandra Summer Palace of King Rama VI.

Bangkok is about an hour drive away, making Christian University of Thailand accessible to one of Asia's greatest metropolitan centers and to the rest of the world. Christian University of Thailand is also strategically located at the crossroads between the west side of Thailand and the southern peninsula.
